

Admission requirements for postgraduate studies (Magister, Licentiate or Doctorate)

For the Admission procedure at the **Collegium Canisianum** the bishop or higher superior needs to send the following:

- Application for admission by the bishop/higher superior
- Application for admission by the candidate
- Agreement signed by bishop/higher superior and candidate
- Notitiae personales
- A written and signed statement of the candidate explaining why he wants to study in Innsbruck and his motivation to do so in Collegium Canisianum
- Curriculum Vitae (indicating the situation of the family: father, mother, brothers and sisters)
- Recommendation by the bishop or the higher superior (please explain why the candidate is especially suited regarding his personal maturity, his growing in faith, his interest in serving the universal church, his qualities for studies)
- Experience as a priest so far
- Abstract of intended postgraduate studies (3 pages outline)
- Which work in the diocese is the candidate preparing for?
- Our candidates are expected to study German already in their home countries. It is absolutely necessary that the candidate has already reached the **level C1** of the "Common European Reference Framework for languages (GER)".
- **Necessary documents in order to apply for admission at the University of Innsbruck** (will be forwarded to the University by the Collegium Canisianum)
- Applications for "Doctoral Studies": At the University of Innsbruck a Licentiate or a Magister in Theology (M.Th.) is required.
