

A G R E E M E N T
FOR THE STAY OF FATHER
IN COLLEGIUM CANISIANUM

1. The formation period is intended primarily for theological or philosophical studies (Master, Magister, Licenciate, Doctor or PhD programme: please underline) with specialisation in
at the Theological Faculty of Innsbruck in accordance with the "Ratio Localis" of the Collegium Canisianum (cf website).
2. A first period of his stay is granted until..... After an evaluation a second period for the finalization of the doctoral thesis will be granted if necessary and adequate for Father
and the Collegium Canisianum.
3. The Collegium Canisianum will cover the following expenses: meals, accommodation, university fee, medical insurance for students. The additional pocket money is meant for life expenses, study materials, certain travel expenses etc. The expenses are partly covered by
4. The celebration of the liturgy and common prayers are the centre of our community life. Mass intentions (in connection with mass stipends) are granted by the Collegium Canisianum under certain conditions: The Eucharistic celebrations in the Collegium Canisianum are celebrated in the frame of the daily community mass (no private masses).
5. Throughout his stay Father is a member of the Collegium Canisianum. Under the guidance of its Rector, who represents during this formation period the Bishop respectively the Higher Superior, and his team, the student is bound to the ratio localis. He is expected to take part in common programmes of the house and to be ready to deal with ongoing formation and cross-cultural relations. Father will be living in the Collegium; any absence over night and travelling outside Austria has to be registered with the Rector in advance.
6. A report on the progress of studies is expected each academic semester and will be evaluated together.
7. Priestly ministry is foreseen in a limited frame. Pastoral activities have to be arranged with the Rector in accordance with the schedule of the Collegium Canisianum, the progress of studies and in accordance with the rules of the local dioceses.

8. Each year a holiday period of four weeks is foreseen. In addition to that there is the possibility of spending a time of about six weeks for pastoral work (not included Christmas and Easter holidays) if the progress of studies does allow it.
9. We do not want our students to be involved in fundraising activities for private purposes or church initiatives in the home diocese during their stay in the Collegium Canisianum.
10. The place in the Collegium Canisianum offered to Father is meant for the benefit of the church in the home diocese/congregation. Therefore, the return after the end of the period is obligatory. The expenses for the flight back home will be covered by the Collegium Canisianum if the return takes place within a frame of four weeks after the final examination.
11. In case of offences against the rules even the separation from the Collegium Canisianum can be the consequence.
12. Our intention is to serve the pastoral need in the home dioceses and congregations of our students. Therefore, we request from you the reimbursement of € 7.500,00 in case a priestly assignment is taken over in a German speaking European diocese within about five years after leaving the Collegium Canisianum as part of the expenses of the Collegium Canisianum.
