

Requirements for Admission for postgraduate studies Magister/Master – Licentiate – Doctorate/PhD

Necessary documents in order to apply for admission at the University of Innsbruck:

- The Collegium Canisianum will forward the complete set of documents to the University Admission Department.
- In order to enter a Doctoral/PhD program the degree of a Magister/Master or a Licentiate is a prerequisite.
- In order to register as an ordinary student it is necessary that the candidate has reached the level B2 of the "Common European Reference Framework for languages" in the German language. We expect our candidates to study German already in their home countries.

4. **Diploma supplement** if available
5. **Transcripts:** official record of mode and length of completed
 - philosophical and
 - theological programme(s)
6. **Abstract** of your diploma thesis, master thesis or licentiate thesis
7. Please compose a **tabular curriculum vitae** which should pay particular attention to your educational background.
8. **For Diploma programmes:**
 - Secondary School Leaving Certificate or
 - Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate
