

Requirements for Admission to the Collegium Canisianum

An application for admission to the Collegium Canisianum should be sent by the bishop or religious superior – by email addressed to rektor@canisianum.at – and should include the following documents. Please note that the upper age limit for a candidate is 35 years.

1. Formal Request for admission by the bishop/religious superior (see attached sheet)

2. Letter of recommendation written by the bishop/the religious superior which should include the following points:
 - Reasons why the candidate seems especially suited for admission to the Collegium Canisianum (such as: his maturity of character, his desire to deepen his faith, his interest in serving the universal Church, his aptitude for university/academic studies)
 - His experiences as a priest so far
 - What role is the candidate likely to have after completing his studies?

3. Formal Request for admission by the candidate (see attached sheet)

4. Personal application by the candidate written and signed by him explaining
 - why he wants to study in the Collegium Canisianum and what he expects from this
 - the course of studies he intends to pursue

5. Agreement with regard to the candidate's stay in the Collegium Canisianum (see attached sheet)

6. Notitiae personales (see attached sheet)

7. Curriculum Vitae

8. Copy of passport
